- Receive some great resources and strategies for helping your child at home with reading, writing, and math activities. Learn about some great online books and learning games.

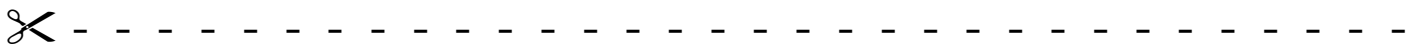
Course #1: Each parent will visit their child's classroom, while students gather separately for fun activities. (Parents will have a chance to visit more than 1 teacher.)
